Legislative update – Gail reported new law allowing Elections to contact a voter if their signature does not match. In the past the law only addresses missing signatures.

November 6, 2018 election -

Poll Worker training – Began on Tuesday 10/16. We have 14 Clerk/Inspector Classes, 14 Inspector Workshops, and 20 EVS classes scheduled between 10/16 and Election Day. Veronica is doing great as our blind voter!

Voting update – Much voter interest. We have currently issued over 103,000 vote-by-mail ballots and our voter registration is at 156,000 and rising. Deadline to register and still be on the voter rolls for 11/6/2018 is 10/22/2018. There are two new ballot drop box locations in Freedom and at the Polo Grounds in Aptos.

Election Day activities – Lots going on. We will need help for ballot pick-up during the day and at 8pm. Shiri said she can be a runner on Election Day afternoon/evening.

Election observation – The Logic and Accuracy Board is currently at the Operations center. Everything appears to be running smoothly

We have a new polling site location for this Election. DeAnza Mobile Home Park on the West Side of Santa Cruz. Information on the proposed site was presented and was approved.
