#### **Permissive and Non-Permissive Access to Voter Registration**

*Election Code § 2187, 2188, 2194; Government Code § 6254.4*

**VOTER INFORMATION** Shall not be used for any personal, private, or commercial purpose.

- **ELECTION PURPOSES:** Permissible uses of information obtained from a source agency shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following: using registration information for purposes of communicating with voters in connection with any election. For example: phone banks, walk precincts, mailings which campaign for or against any candidate or ballot measure in any election, etc.
- **SCHOLARLY PURPOSES:** Students working on a thesis, professors researching voting patterns and other academics involved in research.
- **JOURNALISTIC PURPOSES:** Members of the media are permitted access.
- **POLITICAL PURPOSES:** For example: persons who communicate with voters concerning legislation, vendors who provide information only to candidates, ballot measure committees, political parties and persons or organizations communicating with the voters about political issues whether or not this use is in conjunction with a specific election.
- **GOVERNMENTAL PURPOSES:** For example: the Jury Commissioner, District Attorney, Public Defender or other public government agency.
