

June 7, 2022 Statewide Primary Election
Important dates for jurisdictions calling elections
 (as of 2/18/21 – subject to change)

Dec. 16, 2021 – Feb. 9, 2022	Signature in Lieu filing period.
January 2022	Suggested time for jurisdictions holding elections in June 2022 to pass a resolution that 1) orders the election; 2) requests the Santa Cruz County Elections Department to conduct the election, and 3) consolidates it with any other jurisdiction holding an election on that same day.
Jan. 31 – Feb. 9, 2022	Declaration of Intent for Judges. If the incumbent does not file, filing is extended for 5 calendar days to February 14 for anyone other than the incumbent to file.
Feb. 14 – March 11, 2022	Candidate Nomination Period. If the incumbent does not file, filing is extended for 5 calendar days to March 16 for anyone other than the incumbent to file.
March 11, 2022	Last day to call an election or file for office.
March 11, 2022	Deadline for filing tax rate statement for bond measures appearing on the June ballot.
March 18, 2022	Deadline for filing arguments for or against local ballot measures. Deadline for filing analyses of local ballot measures.
March 25, 2022	Deadline for filing rebuttals.
April 8, 2022	First day to mail ballots to military and overseas voters.
May 9, 2022	First day to mail ballots to vote-by-mail voters.
May 23, 2022	Last day to register to vote in June 2022 election.
May 24 – June 7, 2022	For those who missed the deadline to register, they can still register and vote at the county elections office or designated location.
June 4 & June 5, 2022	Weekend voting – Locations will be open from 9am to 5pm for voting. Locations will be posted by April 1.
June 7, 2022	Election Day – polls open at 7am and close at 8pm.
June 10, 2022	E+3 – VBM ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received by June 10 will be counted.
July 3, 2022	E+26 – last day to cure an unsigned signature on VBM envelope.
