

**June 7, 2022 Statewide Primary Election**  
**Important dates for jurisdictions calling elections**  
 (as of 12/02/2021 – subject to change)

<b>Jan. 3, 2022 – Feb. 9, 2022</b>	Signature in Lieu filing period.
<b>January 2022</b>	Suggested time for jurisdictions holding elections in November to pass a resolution that 1) orders the election; 2) requests the Santa Cruz County Elections Department to conduct the election, and 3) consolidates it with any other jurisdiction holding an election on that same day.
<b>Jan. 31 – Feb. 9, 2022</b>	Declaration of Intent for Judges. If the incumbent does not file, filing is extended for 5 calendar days to February 14 for anyone other than the incumbent to file.
<b>Feb. 14 – March 11, 2022</b>	Candidate Nomination Period. If the incumbent does not file, filing is extended for 5 calendar days to March 16 for anyone other than the incumbent to file.
<b>March 11, 2022</b>	Last day to call an election or file for office
<b>March 11, 2022</b>	Deadline for filing tax rate statement for bond measures appearing on the June ballot.
<b>March 18, 2022</b>	Deadline for filing arguments for or against local ballot measures. Deadline for filing analyses of local ballot measures.
<b>March 25, 2022</b>	Deadline for filing rebuttals.
<b>April 8, 2022</b>	First day to mail ballots to military and overseas voters.
<b>May 9, 2022</b>	First day to mail ballots to vote-by-mail voters.
<b>May 23, 2022</b>	Last day to register to vote in June 2022 election.
<b>May 24 – June 7, 2022</b>	For those who missed the deadline to register, they can still register and vote at the county elections office or designated location.
<b>June 4 &amp; June 5, 2022</b>	Weekend voting – Locations will be open from 9am to 5pm for voting. Locations will be posted by April 1.
<b>June 7, 2022</b>	Election Day – polls open at 7am and close at 8pm.
<b>June 10, 2022</b>	E+3 – VBM ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received by June 10 will be counted.
<b>July 3, 2022</b>	E+26 – last day to cure an unsigned signature on VBM envelope.
