


Vote by mail

Request a vote-by-mail ballot by Oct. 30.

Return it by mail, deliver it to the Registrar of Voters office, or drop it off at any polling place on Election Day.

Vote-by-mail ballots must be postmarked or delivered to a polling place by **November 6.**


Vote early in person

Both locations will also be open Saturday and Sunday, November 3 and 4, 9am to 5pm
